

REALTIME TRANSCRIPT SERVICES INFORMATION

COURTROOM REALTIME

Courtroom realtime is transmitted wirelessly via WiFi. Persons within your firm designated to receive a courtroom realtime feed should contact the court reporter in advance of trial to obtain access sites, codes, and passwords.

Bridge Mobile can be accessed by going to www.connect.eclipsecat.com on any computer, tablet, or phone with internet capabilities, clicking on the lightning bolt in the lower left-hand corner, and then entering the session name and password.

CaseViewNet can be installed on a WIFI capable laptop (pc) or can be placed in the palm of your hand via the free iPad app. Information regarding the latest version of CaseViewNet as well as the software itself can be downloaded by going to the [Stenograph Website](#).

REMOTE REALTIME

With the Judge's approval, WiFi feeds can be utilized to provide internet streaming of the realtime transcript to a remote location such as a war room, firm office, client office, or wherever there is an internet connection available. Once a realtime draft copy has been purchased, counsel will have access to the realtime stream by simply connecting to the internet and logging in. The complete day's transcript will remain available as long as you log in before the end of the trial day and can then be saved or e-mailed for further use. There are no access or daily transmission fees.
